County, Fort Bragg Renew Army Community Covenant

FAYETTEVILLE – Cumberland County and Fort Bragg officials will sign an Army Community Covenant during a brief ceremony Monday, March 23, at 1 p.m. in Room 118 of the Cumberland County Courthouse. The ceremony will highlight the partnership between the Army and the County in supporting soldiers and their families.

Lt. Gen. Joseph Anderson, Commanding General of the XVIII Airborne Corps and Fort Bragg, and Command Sgt. Maj. Isaia Vimoto will join Chairman Kenneth Edge and County Manager Amy Cannon in signing the covenant.

The Army Community Covenant program started in 2008 as a way to foster and sustain effective state and community partnerships with the Army. Anderson and Vimoto will participate in a similar ceremony with the City of Fayetteville at 11:30 a.m. Monday.
