Cooperative Extension's Better Living Series will feature two educational workshops in June. Both workshops will be held at the Cumberland County Cooperative Extension Center, 301 E. Mountain Dr., Fayetteville.

"Green with Envy - Summer Lawn Care Tips" will be offered June 9 from 12 noon to 1:30 p.m. Cooperative Extension staff will provide information on maintaining lawns during hot summer temperatures. Topics will include understanding irrigation, fertilizer use and pest management. Participants will learn how to keep their lawns green and free of weeds during the summer months. The workshop is free. Pre-registration is requested.

"Basic Water Bath Canning" will be offered on June 25 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon. Participants will learn the basics of water bath canning using hands-on-techniques for preserving high acid foods. Each participant will complete the workshop with a preserved item. Pre-registration is required for this workshop. There is a \$10 registration fee to cover the cost of supplies. The fee must be paid before attending the workshop.
