Proposed South Central Land Use Plan Public Hearing May 19

FAYETTEVILLE – The Joint Planning Board will hold a public hearing for the Proposed South Central Land Use Plan on May 19 at 7 p.m. in Room No. 3 of the Historic Courthouse, 130 Gillespie St.

The public hearing will give residents an opportunity to present their comments and concerns about the plan. The Cumberland County Planning and Inspections Department staff encourages all interested parties to attend the hearing.

The Proposed South Central Land Use Plan study area is generally defined as south of the Crown Coliseum Complex and City of Fayetteville line; west of the Cape Fear River, east of Eastern Boulevard and north of the Bladen and Robeson County lines.
