Public Hearing on Early Voting is Nov. 19 at 4 p.m.

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Elections will hold a public hearing Thursday, Nov. 19, at 4 p.m. in the conference room at the E. Newton Smith Center, 227 Fountainhead Lane, to accept public comment about the proposed early voting hours for the 2016 North Carolina primary elections on March 15.

The plan would open one-stop sites at the Board of Elections, Cliffdale Recreation Center, North Regional Library, Hope Mills Recreation Center and East Regional Library. One Stop voting will begin March 3 and end March 12.

The Board of Elections is located at 227 Fountainhead Lane in the E. Newton Smith Center. Regular hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
