Crown Complex Receives Clean Audit

FAYETTEVILLE, NC— Spectra Venue Management and the Cumberland County Civic Center Commission are pleased to announce the results of the Crown Complex fiscal year 2015 audit. Cherry Bekaert CPAs and Advisors conducted the audit and no discrepancies were found in the special-purpose financial statements for the sport and entertainment complex.

The Crown Complex, a County-owned facility, has been privately managed by the Philadelphia-based company Spectra Venue Management since November 2013. In fiscal year 2015, Spectra Venue Management saved county tax payers by reducing the operating losses by \$800,000 over fiscal year 2014, and Spectra continues to drive down the loss in the first two quarters of the fiscal year 2016.
