FAYETTEVILLE – Cumberland County Commissioner Charles Evans is the new second vice president of the North Carolina Association of Black County Officials. Evans was sworn in during the organization’s luncheon on Aug. 13 during the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners annual conference in Forsyth County.

“I am very grateful and humbled by this opportunity to serve the citizens of Cumberland County and North Carolina through this organization,” Evans said.
