Faircloth Elected NCACC District 6 Director

FAYETTEVILLE – Marshall Faircloth, chairman of the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners, was elected to a two-year term as the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners District 6 Director during the association’s annual conference on Aug. 13 in Forsyth County.

“I am honored to represent our District 6 counties on the NCACC Board of Directors for the ensuing term,” Faircloth said. District 6 includes Cumberland, Harnett and Sampson counties.

Faircloth was first elected to the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners as a District 2 representative in 1992 and served until 1996. He was re-elected to the board in 2008 and his current four-year term expires in 2016. He has served three terms as the board’s vice chairman and served as chairman in 2012 and in 2016.

He is a former chairman of the Cumberland County Board of Education and City of Fayetteville Planning Commission.
