## **Proposed Southeast Land Use Plan Public Hearing Sept. 19**

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing about the proposed Southeast Land Use Plan on Sept. 19 at 6:45 p.m. during their regular meeting in Room 118 of the Courthouse, 117 Dick St. Anyone wishing to speak during the public hearing must register with the Clerk to the Board prior to the start of the meeting or by calling 910-678-7771.

The public hearing will give residents an opportunity to present their comments and concerns about the proposed plan. The Cumberland County Planning and Inspections Department encourages and invites all interested parties to attend this hearing.

In general terms, the proposed Southeast Land Use Plan covers the part of the county defined to the south by Bladen County; to the west by the Cape Fear River, Cedar Creek and Cedar Creek Road; on the east by Sampson County and on the north by N.C. Highway 210. The Joint Planning Board unanimously approved the proposed Southeast Land Use Plan on Aug. 16.
