FAYETTEVILLE – Cumberland County 4-H Youth member Ashlyn Johnson served as the Youth Summit Delegate for Cumberland County at the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners (NCACC) Conference held Aug. 11-14 in Forsyth County.

Johnson is a rising sophomore student-athlete at Village Christian Academy in Fayetteville. Johnson is a member of the Cumberland County Thunder Hooves 4-H Club, Cumberland County 4-H Youth Council and the Cumberland County Jr. Fair Advisory Board. Johnson won the gold medal in her age division in the 4-H County Activity Day, where she qualified for District competition in public speaking and demonstrations. Johnson also completed the 4-H Youth Government Tour held July 25-29. She is the daughter of Billy and Lisha Johnson.
