Cumberland County Cooperative Extension is excited to announce the 2017 Better Living Series workshops. There are a variety of workshops offered, from gardening basics to canning. Each class requires preregistration and a workshop fee. Workshop fees vary; please check the registration form or Better Living Flyer for workshop information.

Two workshops are planned for January 2017.

The workshop Pruning Grapevines & Training Fruit Trees will be held on Jan. 10. Participants will learn how to improve the quality and yield from fruit trees and grapevines. The \$5 registration fee is due by Jan. 5.

The workshop Do-It-Yourself Fruit Bouquets will be held Jan. 31. Attendees will learn the basic techniques for creating small fruit bouquets. The \$10 registration fee is due by Jan. 26. Class size is limited, so early application is encouraged.
