Storm Debris Pick-Up Suspended Monday Due to Weather

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. – Storm debris collection in the unincorporated areas has been suspended today, Monday, Dec. 19, due to weather conditions and their impact on the roads at the landfill where trucks are hauling the materials.

Operations will resume Tuesday morning, weather permitting.

On Friday, Saturday and Sunday, a total of approximately 168 tons of construction and demolition debris was collected in severely affected neighborhoods of the county's unincorporated areas.

Cumberland County has contracted with two companies for debris-related services. Ceres Environmental Services has been hired to remove debris in the unincorporated areas and haul it to the appropriate landfill. Landfall Strategies has been hired to manage and monitor the process.
