## **Board of Elections Reminds Voters of Registration Deadline**

FAYETTEVILLE – Friday, Feb. 19, is the deadline to register to vote in the North Carolina primary on March 15. The Cumberland County Board of Elections also reminds voters of the new requirement to show acceptable photo ID at the polls.

Citizens who are not registered to vote by the Feb. 19 deadline may do same-day registration during One-Stop early voting if they provide acceptable documentation. One-Stop Voting begins March 3 and ends March 12. For more information, call 678-7733 or go to [co.cumberland.nc.us/elections](http://co.cumberland.nc.us/elections).

Registered voters will be required to show acceptable photo ID at the polls. Examples of acceptable photo ID include North Carolina driver's license or ID card, passport, military ID, Veterans Administration card and certain tribal ID cards. ### **Republican and Unaffiliated Poll Workers Needed**

Precinct workers who are registered Republicans or unaffiliated are still needed to work on March 15. An application is available online at [co.cumberland.nc.us/elctions](http://co.cumberland.nc.us/elctions). Look for the "Poll Worker Interest Application" link or call 678-7733 as soon as possible. A five-hour training session is required. The Board of Elections is located at 227 Fountainhead Lane.
