## **One-Stop Early Voting Runs March 3-12**

FAYETTEVILLE – One-Stop early voting for the North Carolina primary election begins Thursday, March 3, and ends March 12. The primary election is March 15. Citizens who want to take advantage of early voting, but are not registered to vote, may do same-day registration during One-Stop early voting if they provide acceptable documentation.

### **ID Required To Vote**

Voters will be required to show acceptable photo ID at the polls. Examples of acceptable photo ID include North Carolina driver's license or ID card, passport, military ID, Veterans Administration card and certain tribal ID cards.
