Cumberland County Cooperative Extension's Better Living Series will provide two workshops in July. Each workshop requires pre-registration and class registration fee payment at least two business days before the workshop. Workshop fees vary; please check individual workshops for fee schedule.

Both workshops offered in July will be held at the Cumberland County Cooperative Extension Center, located at 301 East Mountain Drive, Fayetteville.

“Got Gardening Problems? Get Solutions” will be offered July 12 from 12:00 - 1:30 p.m. Cooperative Extension staff will share information and answers to common garden problems found in this area. The \$5 registration fee is due by July 7.

“Safe Pressure Canning for Garden Vegetables” will be offered on July 21 from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Cooperative Extension staff will teach the basics of preserving low-acid foods. Participants will experience hands-on learning by canning green beans during the workshop. **Class size is limited, so individuals are encouraged to sign up early.** The \$10 workshop fee is due on or before July 18.
