## Gathering for Primary Election Results Moves to DSS

FAYETTEVILLE – The public is invited to view election results from the March 15 primary in the first floor conference rooms at the Department of Social Services, 1225 Ramsey St., once polls close at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday.

Election results will be projected from the State Board of Elections onto large screens and candidates, supporters, media outlets and residents are welcome to gather together to await the numbers.

Voters can also track election results by visiting [co.cumberland.nc.us/elections.aspx](http://co.cumberland.nc.us/elections.aspx). Look for the “March 2016 Elections Results” link.

Tuesday the polls will open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 7:30 p.m. On Election Day, voters must go to their precinct polling place to vote. To find information about your precinct, use the County’s Polling Place Finder at <http://gis.co.cumberland.nc.us/PollingPlaceFinder/>.

### **ID Required To Vote**

Voters will be required to show acceptable photo ID at the polls. Examples of acceptable photo ID include North Carolina driver’s license or ID card, passport, military ID, Veterans Affairs card and certain tribal ID cards.

Information on required ID, or options for residents who don’t have or are not able to obtain an ID, can be found online at [voterID.nc.gov](http://voterID.nc.gov) or by calling toll-free 866-522-4723.

If you do not have a voter ID and you have a reasonable impediment, you will be allowed to complete a form and vote a provisional ballot.
