One-Stop Early Voting Runs May 26 – June 4

FAYETTEVILLE – One-Stop early voting for the North Carolina primary election begins Thursday, May 26, and ends June 4. Early voting is for the N.C. Congressional primary. The ballot for Cumberland County voters includes Republican primary races for Congressional Districts 8 and 9, as well as the non-partisan N.C. Supreme Court race. Citizens who want to take advantage of early voting, but are not registered to vote, may do same-day registration during One-Stop early voting if they provide acceptable documentation.

The elected offices on the ballot are listed below:

Congressional District 8, Republican Ballot – Richard Hudson and Tim D'Annunzio

Congressional District 9, Republican Ballot – Mark Harris, Todd Johnson and Robert Pittenger

N.C. Supreme Court Associate Justice – Michael R. Morgan, Daniel Robertson, Robert H. Edmunds, Sabra Faires

One-Stop early voting will be held at the Cumberland County Board of Elections Office, located in the E. Newton Smith Center at 227 Fountainhead Lane, Fayetteville. Dates and times are listed below:

May 26 – 27 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. May 31 – June 3 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. June 4 (Saturday) 9 a.m. – 1 p.m.

The Board of Elections will be closed on Monday, May 30, in observance of the Memorial Day Holiday.

ID Required To Vote

Voters will be required to show acceptable photo ID at the polls. Examples of acceptable photo ID include North Carolina driver's license or ID card, passport, military ID, Veterans Administration card and certain tribal ID cards.
