

## Peak Season Soil Sample Fee Returns

The N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services reminds growers of the return of the peak season soil sample fee beginning Dec. 1 and continuing through March 31, 2017. The cost will be \$4 per sample.

To avoid the fee, soil samples must be delivered to the Agronomic Division by 6 p.m., Wednesday, Nov. 30. Clients who choose to use a private delivery service or the U.S. Postal Service need to account for possible shipping delays to ensure that delivery happens before the state of the peak-season fee. Cumberland County Cooperative Extension will make a delivery on Nov. 28. Soil samples must be in the Extension office on Monday, Nov. 28. The office is in the Agriculture Center, 301 East Mountain Drive, Fayetteville.
