Cotton Fire Voting Precinct Moved To Stoney Point

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Elections reminds voters in Hope Mills precinct 02A, G9B-1, that their polling site has been moved to Stoney Point Fire Department (Station 19), located at 2906 Lake Upchurch Rd. The precinct’s normal polling place, Cotton Fire Department located at 4618 Calico St., Hope Mills, was damaged by flooding caused by Hurricane Matthew and cannot be used in the November General Election.

The Board of Elections sent letters to voters in Hope Mills precinct 02A announcing the polling place change. Citizens who have questions can call the Board of Elections at 910-678-7733 or go to the office in the E. Newton Smith Center, 227 Fountainhead Lane, Fayetteville.
