Landfill Extends Fee Waivers Until Oct. 31 Wilkes Road Processing Site Opens 7 Days A Week During October

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. – Cumberland County is extending tipping fee waivers for storm-related material at the Ann Street Landfill and Wilkes Road Treatment and Processing Facility through **Oct. 31**. The waiver only applies to non-commercial haulers.

In order to assist citizens recovering from Hurricane Matthew, the County is also opening the Wilkes Road Treatment and Processing Facility seven days a week from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. through Oct. 31. The facility at 771 Wilkes Rd. accepts yard debris like tree wood and limbs.

The Ann Street Landfill, located at 698 Ann St., will offer extended hours from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday, Oct. 22 and 29. The Ann Street site will not be open on Sunday. Weekday hours next week, Oct. 24 – 28, have been extended by one hour. The hours are 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. You should take construction and demolition materials damaged by the storm as well as household furniture and other garbage to the Ann Street Landfill.
