## **Landfills Open Sunday, Waive Fees, Extend Hours Next Week**

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. – In order to assist citizens in recovering from Hurricane Matthew, Cumberland County will open the two landfills on Sunday. The County is waiving fees charged to residents for yard debris and construction and demolition materials through Oct. 22. The waiver only applies to non-commercial haulers.

The Ann Street Landfill, 698 Ann St., will be open Sunday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Monday through Friday, Oct. 17-21, from 6:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. The Ann Street Landfill takes construction and demolition materials.

The Wilkes Road Treatment and Processing Facility, 771 Wilkes Road, will be open on Sunday from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m. and Monday through Friday, Oct. 17-21, from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m. Vegetative debris like tree wood and limbs should be taken to the Wilkes Road facility.
