Shelter Update: 275 People Now Housed at Four Facilities JIC Media Release 11 p.m.

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. – A fourth emergency shelter has been opened at the Kiwanis Recreation Center at 352 Devers. So far, 275 people have reported to the four shelters. The shelter at South View High School has moved to South View Middle School. The other locations are Smith Recreation Center and Spring Lake Recreation Center. The newly opened Kiwanis Recreation Center has the greatest capacity.

Residents are reminded to bring any medication or special foods for dietary needs, including baby formula, as well as blankets, pillows and if possible, food to last 24 hours.

There have been 141 swift water rescues with 502 people rescued.
