## **‘Remember My Name’ Domestic Violence Vigil Sept. 23**

FAYETTEVILLE – A candlelight vigil will be held Sept. 23 at 5:30 p.m. on the steps of the Cumberland County Courthouse, 117 Dick St., to raise awareness for domestic violence.

Cumberland County Family Court, the CARE Center Family Violence Program, U. S. Army Family Advocacy Program, Army Community Services, Cape Fear Music Center, the Sheriff’s Office, Fayetteville Police Department and other community partners will hold the “Remember My Name” Domestic Violence Vigil in memory of the victims of domestic violence homicides. The names of victims who have died as a result of intimate partner domestic violence over the past year in North Carolina will be read aloud at the vigil.
