FAYETTEVILLE - The emergency shelter at Smith Recreation Center, 1520 Slater Ave., is closing at 9 p.m. on Sept. 29.

The emergency shelter at Spring Lake Recreation Center, 245 Ruth St., Spring Lake, remains open. The Spring Lake Recreation Center is set up to accommodate residents who have pets.

If a resident has a caregiver, the caregiver must remain with the resident at the shelter. Residents who come to a shelter must bring their own medical equipment and medications. Residents are also reminded to notify their home health provider and family members if they leave their home to go to a shelter.

Residents are encouraged to be cautious on roadways due to flooding and monitor local media and the County's website and social media sites for important updates and information.
