## **Spring Lake Shelter Closes at 5 p.m.**

FAYETTEVILLE – The emergency shelter set up in the Spring Lake Recreation Center, 245 Ruth St., Spring Lake, will close at 5 p.m. today.

Cumberland County Emergency Services continues to survey and assess damage from flooding. The County is working with the City of Fayetteville, Public Works Commission, Department of Transportation and the N.C. Division of Emergency Management.

The Long Valley Farm Lake Dam at Carvers Creek State Park, Rhodes Pond Dam in northern Cumberland County at U.S. Highway 301, and the Lake Upchurch Dam in Hope Mills/Parkton continue to be monitored because of high water.

Emergency Services reminds residents to use caution when driving and avoid driving on roads covered by water. Residents are also reminded never to drive around or through barricades on roads that are closed.
