County Seeking Proposals for Jail Health Program

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners has issued a Request for Proposal for qualified health care providers to submit bids to deliver health care services at the Cumberland County Detention Center for the Jail Health Program.

Vendors interested in submitting a contract proposal **MUST** attend a mandatory pre-proposal conference and site visit on April 17 at 9:30 a.m. at the Detention Center, 204 Gillespie St., Fayetteville. The purpose of the conference and site visit is to allow prospective health care providers who are interested in submitting a proposal to view the facility and the scope and nature of work to be performed in the Detention Center. Proposals from healthcare providers who do not attend the conference and site visit will not be considered.
