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## Community Development Seeking Rehabilitation Contractors

FAYETTEVILLE – Contractors are invited to apply for the Cumberland County Community Development approved contractor registry. Contractors are needed for Community Development’s Housing Rehabilitation Program and to rehabilitate homes damaged by Hurricane Matthew in Cumberland County.

Contractors who reside in Cumberland County and want to be added to the contractor registry should apply at Cumberland County Community Development. Contractors added to the contractor registry will be eligible to submit bids to perform housing rehabilitation work in Cumberland County. Contractors are required to have a minimum of \$300,000 in Liability and Workman’s Compensation Insurance administered by the State of North Carolina and must be able to provide references for at least four jobs completed.

Housing rehabilitation is for single-family owner-occupied homes and homes damaged by Hurricane Matthew. Homeowners must reside within Cumberland County but outside the city limits of Fayetteville. Cumberland County has been awarded funds by the North Carolina Housing Finance Agency through the Disaster Recovery Act of 2016. Funding is also provided by the Department of Housing and Urban Development.
