FAYETTEVILLE – Cumberland County Veterans Services will host a Veterans Town Hall meeting June 18 beginning at 6:30 p.m. in the Pate Room of Headquarters Library, 300 Maiden Lane. Veterans Services staff members will give an overview of Veterans Administration benefits and discuss any updates from the regional office. After the presentation, there will be an open forum for questions. The meeting is open to veterans, dependents and anyone interested in learning more about veterans benefits.

Veterans Services will also host a “Pension with Aid and Attendance” informational meeting for the staff of nursing homes, assisted living and home healthcare agencies on June 21 from 2 to 4 p.m. in Conference Room A of the Cumberland County Department of Social Services, 1225 Ramsey St. Pension with Aid and Attendance is a benefit for totally disabled non-service connected veterans, their surviving spouses, and veterans over the age of 65.
