Low Income Energy Assistance Available

FAYETTEVILLE — The Cumberland County Department of Social Services will begin accepting applications on Monday, Nov. 2, for its Low Income Energy Assistance Program. Applications will be accepted Nov. 2 through 13 from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the department located at 1225 Ramsey St.

The office will be closed for Veterans' Day, Nov. 11. However, the office will extend hours on Nov. 12 until 6 p.m. to accept applications.

Individuals must bring in verification of income, Social Security, photo identification, and a current bank statement, if applicable. Households that are determined eligible will receive an energy payment in February.
