Library Hosts Job Fair and Presents Job & Career Resource Centers

FAYETTEVILLE, NC – Looking for a new career? Thinking about going back to school? Disappointed with your current job searching efforts? Have you considered turning to the library for help? The Cumberland County Public Library & Information Center will host a Job Fair on Aug. 11, from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. at Headquarters Library, 300 Maiden Lane. If you cannot work the Job Fair into your schedule, consider visiting a Job & Career Resource Center at your nearest branch.

At the Job Fair, participants will find representatives from schools such as East Carolina University and Fayetteville Technical Community College, who will be on hand to talk about educational opportunities. Representatives from local corporations, public utilities, county and federal governments will also be here to talk about their fields of expertise such as banking, manufacturing and military to name just a few. Classes throughout the day include interview tips and resume review services as well as resume building basics and online job resources.

Library Job & Career Resource Centers are open during regular business hours at each location and 24/7 on the library's website. At the branches, individuals will find job listings, books on careers, job interviews, resumes, and cover letters as well as a computer dedicated to employment resources. Through "Book a Librarian," individuals may request an appointment with a librarian for in-depth assistance. Each branch also provides free wireless internet access for individuals bringing their own laptops for research.
