One-Stop Voting Starts April 19

FAYETTEVILLE – One-stop voting for the May 8 partisan primary starts April 19 at the Board of Elections office at 301 East Russell St. The early voting period ends at 1 p.m. Saturday, May 5 at all locations.

Beginning April 23, four additional sites will offer one-stop voting. They are Cliffdale Recreation Center, East Regional Branch Library, Hope Mills Recreation Center and North Regional Branch Library. From April 30 through May 5, voters can go to the Spring Lake Branch Library.

Hours and locations are posted on the county's website (www.co.cumberland.nc.us) and listed below.

A North Carolina resident who is qualified to vote may register and vote at a one-stop site during the early voting period. To register, you must present an acceptable form of ID. Acceptable forms include a N.C. driver's license with current address; utility bill with voter's name and current address; document from a local, state, or U.S. government agency; passport; government-issued photo ID; U.S. military ID; license to hunt, fish, own a gun, etc.; property or tax bill; automotive registration; certified documentation of naturalization; a check, invoice or letter from a government agency; student ID, along with a document from the school showing student's name and current address; a paycheck or paycheck stub from an employer or a W-2; and a bank statement or bank-issued credit card statement.

This is a partisan primary, and you must vote in the primary for the party in which you are registered. If you are registered as unaffiliated, you may vote in either the Democratic, Republican or Libertarian primary. You also have the option of choosing the Non-Partisan ballot. If you are not sure of the party you are registered, contact the Board of Elections Office at 910-678-7733.
