## **Health Department Declares House Suitable to Occupy**

FAYETTEVILLE, NC – The Environmental Health Section of the Cumberland County Department of Public Health has declared a Gates Four home at 7116 Holmfield Road in Fayetteville suitable to occupy following an Oct. 19 methamphetamine lab investigation by the State Bureau of Investigation.

According to Daniel Ortiz, Environmental Health Supervisor with the Health Department, the SBI removed the bulk contamination at the site during the investigation. On Jan. 20, the homeowner submitted documentation as required by law to the Health Department concerning the cleanup.

According to the documentation, wipe samples from the site were collected and sent to a certified lab on Jan. 10. No methamphetamine was detected. Based on the test results, the Health Department determined the house suitable to occupy.
