(Fayetteville, N.C.) — The City of Fayetteville and Cumberland County invite residents to attend a Facebook Town Hall Meeting featuring the City Environmental Services and County Solid Waste Management Departments on Nov. 23 from noon to 1 p.m.

Environmental Services Director Jerry Dietzen and County Solid Waste Director Bobby Howard will be available to answer your questions. Topics that can be discussed during the Facebook Town Hall meeting include:

- Environmental Services;
 - Pickup schedules for trash and yard waste
 - Trash pickup; what can and cannot be placed in household trash
 - Yard waste pickup; what can and cannot be placed in yard waste
 - Recycling; what can and cannot be placed in recycling
 - Bulky pickup services; what can and cannot be picked up
 - What to do about missed pickups
 - How to get Roll-Out carts repaired
 - Banned landfill items
 - What to do with unwanted electronics
- Solid Waste Management and Landfill services
 - Various collection sites and recycling centers open to county residents
 - How to dispose of household hazardous waste, to include oil, batteries, antifreeze
 - Acceptable and banned landfill items

“We are looking forward to partnering with the City in providing information to our citizens about the Ann Street Landfill and Solid Waste Management,” said Sally Shutt, County Public Information Director.
