Front Courthouse Entrance Will Close Today at 1 p.m. for Lettering Installation

FAYETTEVILLE – The front entrance of the Cumberland County Courthouse will close at 1 p.m. today while workers install lettering to rename the building the Judge E. Maurice Braswell Cumberland County Courthouse. People entering or exiting the building will use the South Cool Spring Street entrance on the rear of the building, or the Person Street entrance on the side of the Courthouse, which will be open this afternoon. The Courthouse front entrance will reopen as normal Friday at 8 a.m.

Dick Street in front of the Courthouse and the Law Enforcement Center will remain open, but the courtyard in front of the Courthouse will be closed to pedestrians.

A formal dedication ceremony to rename the Cumberland County Courthouse the Judge E. Maurice Braswell Cumberland County Courthouse will be held Sept. 20 at 9 a.m. in the courtyard at the front entrance of the courthouse. A plaque will be unveiled at the ceremony, which will coincide with the 240th Anniversary of the Cumberland County Superior Court.
