Godwin Breaks Ground on Recreation Room Addition to Town Hall

GODWIN, NC – The Town of Godwin held a ground-breaking ceremony today for a new recreation room addition to Town Hall.

The 2,104-square-foot addition will include a large multipurpose room, restrooms, a janitor's closet and storage room. The expansion will tie directly into the building's existing kitchen.

The Town Hall at 4924 Markham Street is adjacent to the Godwin Town Park and residents will be able to rent the indoor space from the town. The project is expected to cost \$281,000 and will be paid for with Parks & Recreation district tax funding.

“This is a big deal for our community. I never dreamed of anything like this coming to the Town of Godwin,” said Mayor Willie Burnette.

County Commissioners Glenn Adams, Charles Evans and Michael Boose joined in the ground-breaking ceremony.

“The commissioners are always looking to help all the municipalities in this community. We are glad to be out here today to celebrate with you,” said Adams, chairman of the Board of Commissioners.

Hayes Inc. is the contractor for the project, which is being overseen by the Cumberland County Engineering and Infrastructure Department.
