## Precinct Workers Needed For 2017 Municipal Elections

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Elections is seeking precinct workers for the 2017 municipal election Nov. 7.

Interested personnel must be U.S. citizens, registered voters in Cumberland County, be available to attend required training, be able to set up and operate a laptop computer and printer, remain non-partisan on the day of the election and be available to work the entire day from 5:30 a.m. until dismissed by the Chief Judge, usually between 9 and 11 p.m.

Precinct workers are compensated for attending training and for working Election Day.

Precinct workers are assigned to the location where they themselves would vote, however, one out-of-precinct worker may be assigned at each location as needed. The following precincts/polling locations are especially in need of workers, interested persons who live near these locations are encouraged to apply:
