Health Department Partners with Stedman-Wade to Resume Adult Health, Dental Clinics

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Department of Public Health has partnered with Stedman-Wade Health Services, Inc. to resume Adult Health and Dental services beginning Oct. 3. The Health Department's Adult Health and Dental clinics were discontinued in July under the Fiscal Year 2018 budget.

Both clinics will be housed in the Department of Public Health facility located at 1235 Ramsey St., Fayetteville. Patients may begin making appointments immediately by calling 910-433-3600.

The Adult Health clinic will provide comprehensive adult services and will be open Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8 a.m. to noon. The clinic will operate on a sliding fee scale with the minimum payment of \$10.

The Dental clinic will serve adults and children and will be open every second and fourth Tuesday of the month, from 3 to 7 p.m. The clinic will operate on a sliding fee scale with a minimum payment of \$25.

The clinics will be funded until Dec. 31 by a Community Health Grant from the Office of Rural Health, which was awarded to the Department of Public Health. Starting Jan. 1, 2018, Stedman-Wade Health Services will continue providing services at the Department of Public Health at no cost to Cumberland County Government. During this time, the sliding fee scales and hours will be subject to change.

The Health Department will also continue its partnership with Cumberland HealthNET, which serves patients at the Health Department facility every Monday. For more information about Cumberland HealthNET, call 910-483-6869.

“These partnerships speak to the county manager’s directive to explore public-private partnerships in an effort to serve our community,” said Interim Health Director, Rodney Jenkins. “This is the first step in transforming our local healthcare system. The partnership will provide a great benefit to the uninsured and underinsured citizens of Cumberland County by providing affordable healthcare services.”
