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## **Proposed Vander Area Land Use Plan Public Hearing Sept. 18**

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing regarding the proposed Vander Area Land Use Plan on Sept. 18 at 6:45 p.m. during their regular meeting in Room 118 of the Courthouse, 117 Dick St. Anyone wishing to speak during the public hearing must register with the Clerk to the Board before the start of the meeting or by calling 910-678-7771.

The public hearing will give residents an opportunity to present their comments and concerns about the proposed plan. The Cumberland County Planning and Inspections Department encourages and invites all interested parties to attend this hearing.

In general terms, the Vander study area is located in the central part of the county and is defined to the north by Highway 24; to the south by the Cape Fear River, to the east by the Town of Stedman and to the west by the City of Fayetteville. The Joint Planning Board unanimously approved the proposed Vander Area Land Use Plan on Aug. 15.
